

## Local Rules

**Yardage Markers:** You may take free relief from Yardage Markers if it interferes with your stance, your intended swing path or line of play. Nearest point of relief plus one club length, no nearer to the hole

**Out of bounds:** Is defined by the inside edge of the white stakes with red tops and by the inside edge of the fence post of the white double rail fences. Also, by the inside edge of the fence posts of the brown split rail fences to the left of #1 and #4

**Drop Area:** # 13- If your ball comes to rest in the planted circle inside the cart path; Free drop to the left of the cart path. #15 In front of green tee area

**Water Hazards:** Yellow stakes or yellow lines

**Lateral Water Hazards:** Red stakes or red lines

**Stakes and roped areas:** These are Moveable Obstructions Rule 24-1

**Sand paths and service roads:** No relief

**Cart paths-Paved and gravel:** Nearest point of relief plus one club length no closer Rule 24-2  
Areas with white lines tying into paved cart paths, become part of the path.

**Embedded Ball:** A ball embedded in its own pitch mark “through the green”, may be lifted, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to the original spot, no nearer the hole.

**The following are Immoveable Obstructions:**

Horse track fences.

Sprinkler control boxes.

Railroad Ties.

Allow Faster Groups to play through.

Repair all ball marks and sand all divots.

Restrooms located on holes #4, #9, & #16.
